The Beverley D. Tucker Memorial Scholarship

Established in 1925 by the Episcopal Church Women as a memorial to the late Beverley Dandridge Tucker, Bishop of Southern Virginia from 1906 - 1930. It provides assistance to men and women in church-related training in an accredited Episcopal Church training school. Applicants for the Beverley D. Tucker Scholarship must have successfully completed the Diocesan Ordination Exploration Program and been granted postulancy prior to submission of the application. Half of the amount of this scholarship must be repaid within five years.

The Elise Holiday Scholarship

Established by the Episcopal Church Women as a memorial to Elise Holladay, an early president of the ECW of the Diocese of Southern Virginia. It provides assistance to men and women for continued education beyond high school in undergraduate study only. Applications for the Elise Holladay Scholarship may be submitted only twice by the same applicant.

All applications must be accompanied by:

- Letters of recommendation from:
 1. The Rector or other clergy known personally by the applicant, testifying to The need, abilities, and character of the applicant;
 2. A high school guidance counselor personally known by the applicant;
 3. and a person familiar with the applicant's abilities and goals
- A paragraph written by the applicant explaining the reasons why they seek the scholarship and describing their educational goals.
- A copy of the final grades from the previous institution attended.

Re-application for aid made following a grant must be accompanied by grades from the last semester attended and any change in financial situation. No references are needed with re-application.

Awards are available only to Episcopalians living in the Diocese of Southern Virginia.
